

Five Mile River Action Group

Do you live or work near the Five Mile River or Keeler Brook and have ideas about the river? Do you want to have a positive impact on Long Island Sound? The Five Mile River is looking for people to plan and implement actions that will improve the quality of the Five Mile River Watershed. In 2012, a framework for improving the Five Mile River (called the Five Mile River Watershed-Based Plan) was adopted by the elected officials of Norwalk, Darien and New Canaan. After meeting with Mayor Rilling in late 2015, a small Action Group was formed to work on implementing some of the suggested actions in the Plan.
