Re: Project 102-366 - Replacement of the West Cedar Street Bridge Over the Five Mile River

Dear Residents and Business Owners:

The City of Norwalk Department of Operations and Public Works (DPW) Engineering Division, through its contractor, Dayton Construction Company, Inc. expects to commence work on March 12, 2025 on the replacement of the above referenced bridge.

Beginning on approximately April 1, 2025 and running through November 30, 2025, West Cedar Street will be closed to all vehicular traffic between the west side of the westerly intersection of Beechwood Road with West Cedar Street and the west side of the bridge. See the Detour Plan on Page 2 of 2. There will be accommodations for pedestrians throughout most phases of construction via a temporary pedestrian bridge, except when demolition and construction work do not allow for pedestrian passage due to safety concerns.


All residents and businesses will have access to their driveways. The proposed locations of the road closure at the bridge are being set up so that no residential or commercial driveways will fall within the closed and barricaded portion of the roadway.

Vehicular traffic will be detoured in accordance with the attached Detour Plan for the Project (See Page 2 of 2) that has been approved by the Norwalk Traffic Authority. The proposed detour route is from West Cedar Street to West Norwalk Road to Connecticut Avenue to Richards Avenue back to West Cedar Street.
